

How to **copy** a picture from **Google Images** and Paste into Google Doc or Presentation on a **Chromebook !!**

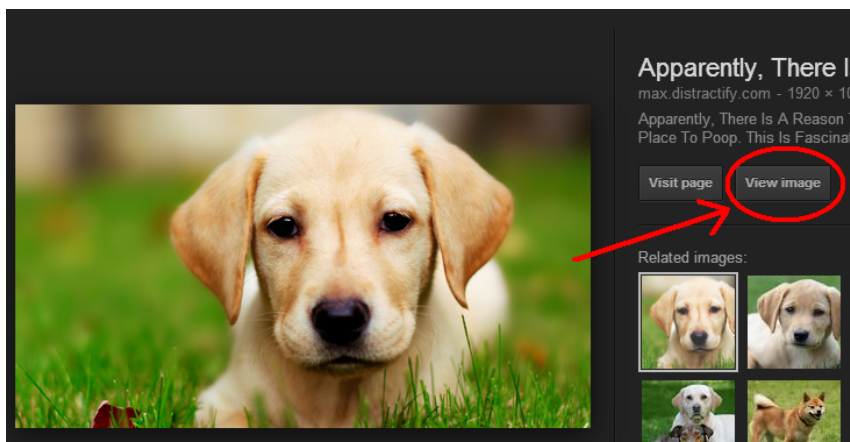
Step1 There is **NO Right Mouse click on a Chrome Book**. So you go to Google Images



and type in what you want . In my case it will be “dog”

Step 2 Click on the Picture of the dog you want and **you will get a larger version of it**.

In the middle right side you will see a **button** called **View image**. Click that button and it will load that image on a separate page



Step 3 The picture is now large and on a separate page.

NB !! In the top right hand corner are 3 bars ...  this is the **settings bar** of Google. Click it and you'll get this window below...simply click the **Copy button**. The picture is now in the **memory** of the computer and can **PASTED ANYWHERE**.>>>Google Doc, Google

Presentation or Google Drawing.....>using **Control V** or **Right mouse button Click** and select **Paste**
